## Michigan Model for Health: Elementary-High School Human Sexuality Institute Grades: 4-12

**Description** State recognized training for sexuality educators in Michigan. This workshop will focus on topics relevant to 4th-12th grade programming.   - Practice answering sensitive classroom questions following district guidelines.
  - Demonstrate age-appropriate teaching strategies and educational materials.
