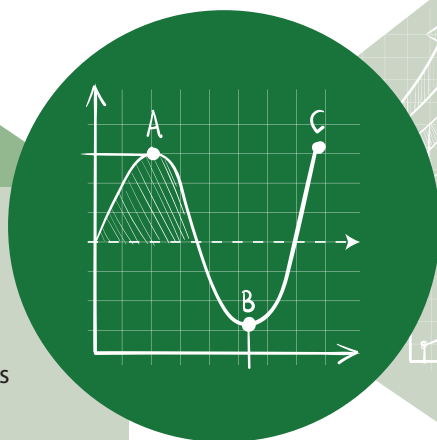
DESCRIPTION

- Engage in interactive tasks like Polygraph (Parabolas) to promote student reasoning and discourse.

This session will help educators develop confidence in using Desmos for instruction, assessment, and student engagement while providing practical strategies for integrating Desmos into daily teaching practices.
