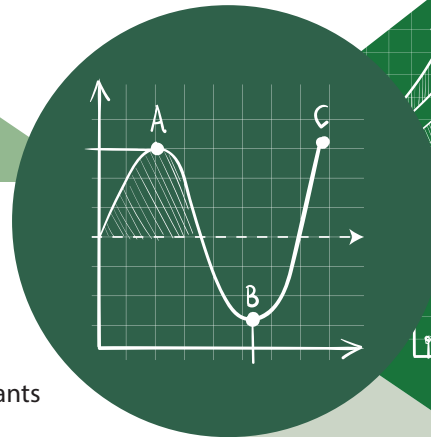

- Explore digital manipulatives with Polypads
- Edit and create custom activities
- Access embedded tools to support diverse learners (e.g., text-to-speech, free response uploads)

By the end of the day, participants will leave with practical strategies, grade-specific resources, and ready-to-use tools to make math learning more engaging and equitable for all students.
