

Hybrid Reproductive Health Bootcamp for Educators

This hybrid training is designed for health and physical education teachers, school counselors, and other educators responsible for delivering reproductive health education in schools. Whether you are new to teaching this content or seeking to enhance your instruction, this bootcamp provides valuable insights, practical tools, and collaborative learning experiences to take back to your classroom.

Day 1: Virtual Session (Pre-Work Required)

The first day will be conducted online, with required pre-work sent at least two weeks before registration closes. Educators will focus on HIV prevention, gaining evidence-based strategies to teach students about:

- Transmission, risk reduction, and stigma
- Current HIV trends and prevention methods
- Michigan laws related to HIV education

Through engaging activities, participants will practice responding to students' common questions, analyzing misconceptions, and modeling inclusive, trauma-informed approaches. By the end of the session, educators will have the knowledge and resources needed to confidently deliver HIV prevention lessons aligned with best practices and state guidelines.

Day 2: In-Person Training at Bay-Arenac ISD

The second day will take place on-site at Bay-Arenac ISD, expanding into broader sex education topics, including:

- Age-appropriate instruction and Michigan's A-K law
- Teaching puberty, consent, healthy relationships, and contraception
- Implementing inclusive and trauma-informed practices

Educators will engage in interactive training that follows a skills-based model (introduction, explanation, modeling, and application). They will also have the opportunity to reflect on their own comfort levels, practice answering challenging student questions, and explore strategies for delivering accurate and supportive sex education.

The day will conclude with action planning, ensuring that participants leave fully prepared to implement engaging and effective reproductive health education in their schools.
